

# GETTING THE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE YOU NEED TO ATTEND COLLEGE

## THE FAFSA + THE ETG

**The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is the pathway to the most financial aid.**

You need to complete the FAFSA to be eligible for financial assistance from the state and federal government for higher education and training. For example, you must complete the FAFSA application to be eligible for the Pell grant, state grant, and Chafee Education and Training Grant (ETG).

**Complete the Chafee Education and Training Grant (Chafee ETG) Application to be Eligible for the PA Tuition Waiver.**

The ETG provides youth with experience in foster care up to \$5000 a year for the cost of enrolling in a program of higher education or training. You are eligible for this grant until age 26. It is a great source of assistance and you must complete it in order to be eligible for the Pennsylvania tuition waiver.
