Make sure that you can use the waiver at the schools you're interested in. These have to be schools in PA AND they have to be Title IV schools OR schools approved by the Department of Education.

Find this out by looking at a school's website, asking their financial aid office or looking at this list: https://bit.ly/SchoolCodeList

Work with your team to make a plan for covering your living expenses. The tuition waiver will not cover room and board or other costs like books and transportation.

Reach out the the 'Points of Contact' at the schools you're interested in.

- They are there to help students who have been in foster care.
- They can help you apply for admissions and financial aid and get access to the waiver.
